2. Will NEMSA **guarantee me in writing** that I will receive one cent more than I am currently making as a result of collective bargaining?
3. What **exactly** will either union do if management says “**NO**” in good faith to any specific union demand? What then?
4. Exactly how much would my union dues be as a NEMSA member? How long would they stay at that amount?
5. How is NEMSA going to pay off its financial obligations since it finished last year with more than \$300,000 in liabilities over assets?
6. How is NEMSA going to pay off the penalties imposed by the court in California amounting to over \$400,000?
7. Why does NEMSA’s whole campaign consist of attempting to “demonize” Tim Fallon by predicting all sorts of terrible things he “will” do after the election? Does the union have a crystal ball?
8. Which of the following have been found guilty after being sued for fraud –
 - A. Tim Fallon
 - or
 - B. NEMSA’s current president?

10. How can Local 6 talk about “protection” when it has only allowed **two** employee grievances to go to arbitration in 35 years?

12. Will either union find me another job if I am permanently replaced while out on a union called strike? Where?
13. If I go out on strike, will either union guarantee to pay my health insurance premiums?
14. Why are union fliers unsigned?
15. Will either union **guarantee me in writing** that I will never be forced to pay the union in order to keep my job here?
16. How is NEMSA doing at AMR – Natick, where the union has been bargaining since **last October**? What’s the problem?
